On Saturday the work crew was Howard and Sandy Morgan and their son Ken, Rod and Fred Smith, and Dave church with his Bobcat.

The sign was put up and looks great.

Both sides of the driveway and both sides of the path down to the Clarks was mowed.

Also the south side of the Cemetery that was cleared last year was mowed and sprayed.

Dave removed all of the Lilacs, wire, and posts from the left side of the driveway to the southwest corner of the cemetery. He also moved all of the branches from the trees that were pruned or cut down to the new burn pile area.

With Rods motorized sprayer all areas where Lilacs were cut down were sprayed.

At our meeting we decided not to gravel the grave sites or the paths to them.

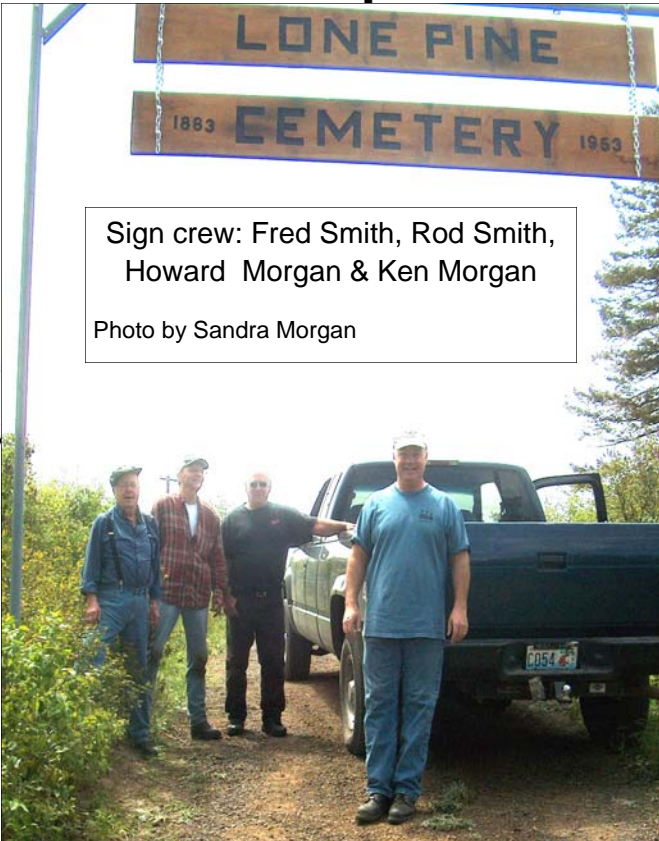
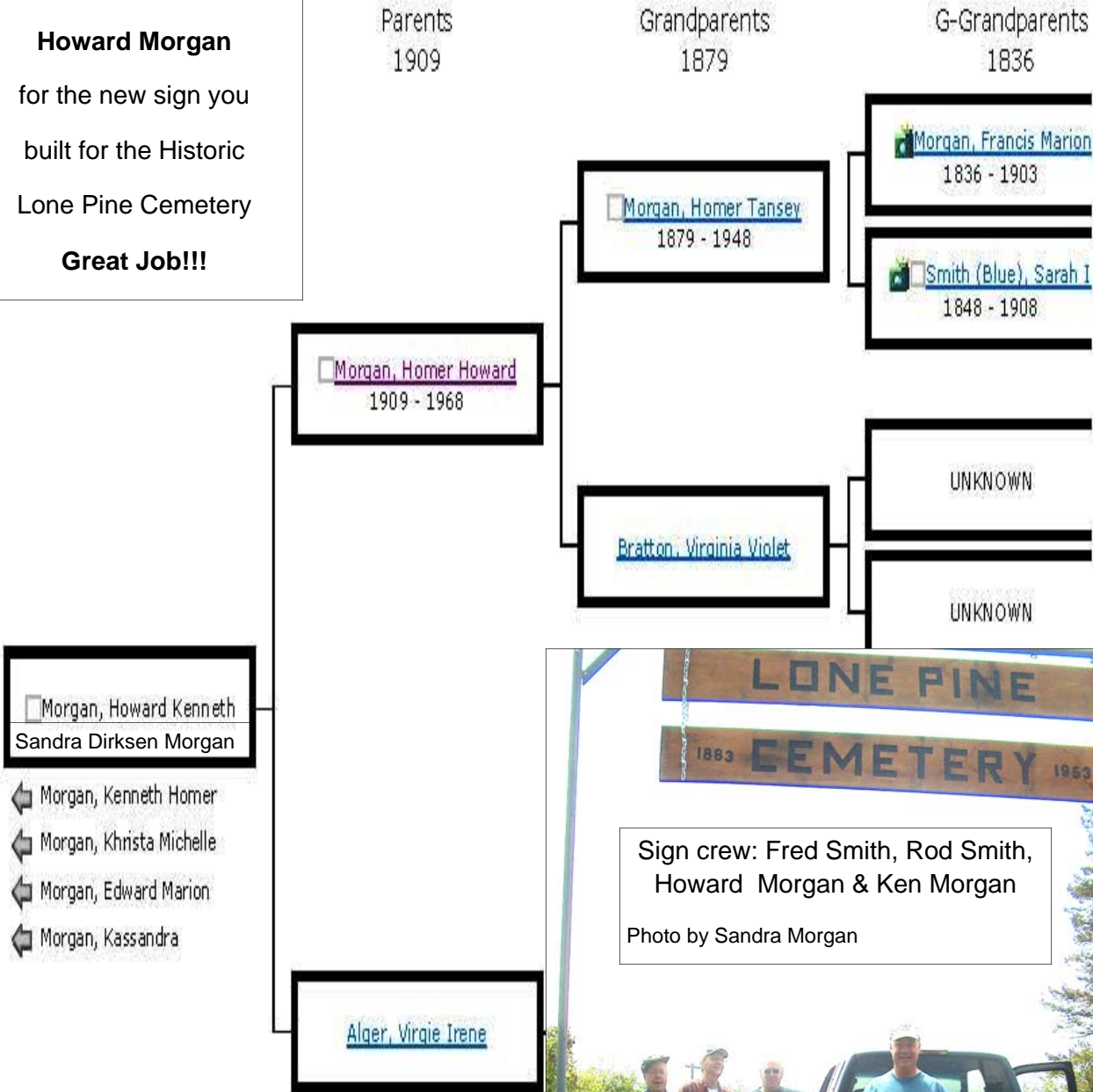
