
Friends of Lone Pine Cemetery President, Fred Smith

has decided it is time for him to step down from the position he has held since the organization was formed in 2007. He has been a very active, hands-on leader in forming the organization as well as helping with the physical work at the cemetery and planning for future projects to make the historic pioneer cemetery accessible and presentable again after many years of neglect.

Fred cited his age, he turned ninety in March this year, and some health concerns that may keep him from being as active as he would like to be. He announced his decision at the Spring meeting at the C&D Bar & Grill in Tekoa WA, on May 11, 2012 and nominated Terry Smiley for his replacement who graciously accepted and was enthusiastically accepted by the group who voted affirmative for his filling the position of President. His wife, Patti agreed to be co-president. Jo Ann Savitz will remain as Vice President and Jim Irwin will remain as Secretary-Treasurer.

Fred was raised in the Northwest and the Whitman County area before joining the U.S. Army at the age of nineteen and becoming a highly decorated Fighter Pilot during WWII in the European and African theatres, flying 173 missions.

After the war he went into the business world as an auto parts salesman and became an executive in a nationwide corporation that made and distributed auto parts. At one point before his retirement he was a Territory Manager for the entire West Coast including Alaska & Hawaii.

**May 11th & 12th meeting and work day reports of the
Friends of Lone Pine Cemetery - 2012**

1. We had two new guests at our meeting, Alan Arnold from Tekoa and Jerry Wagner from Farmington.
2. The placement of the Historic Marker and the new Pine tree was discussed.
3. The Marker was placed at the northwest side of the parking lot. The Pine tree will be placed 3 or 4 feet behind the marker at a later date.
4. It was decided that Jim Irwin will order 25 metal grave markers from W. F. Norman Corporation.
5. The chain link fence will be on hold until more money comes in.
6. It was decided to wait one year to see if the fire damaged trees will recover or be removed.
7. The fire damaged Apple tree and all wire, brush and lilacs were removed from the East and North side of the cemetery.
8. Two crews of chain saw and brush pilers cleaned the area from the parking lot to the north boundary of all lilacs.
9. It was estimated that one third of the cemetery is now clear of all Lilacs and brush
10. Rod Smith mowed the south and west borders of the cemetery as well as the sides of the north-south path. Would have done more but one of his mower tires was punctured.
