James R. Kizer

Seventh burial on the Lone Pine Cemetery timeline.

James R. Kizer was born on 17 Jan 1877 in Iowa as the second child of John Clark Kizer and Martha Ellen Stevenson.

He had five siblings: George Oscar, Anthony, Hughy V., Lottie P, and Jennie B.

He died at the age of 8 on 03 Mar 1885 in Lone Pine, Whitman County, Washington.

Ester Erwin was born on 29 Jan 1811. She died at the age of 77 on Mar. 16, 1885. When she was 22, she married John Scott on 30 May 1833 in Greenbrier, Virginia.

John Scott and Ester Erwin had the following children:

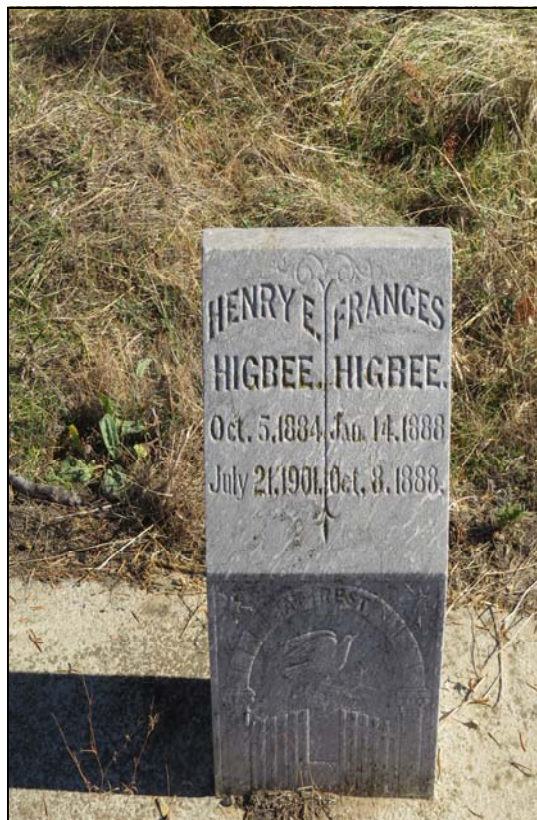
Charles Benjamin Scott was born on 15 Dec 1838.

Frances Higbee was born on 14 Jan 1888 in Whitman, Washington, as the second child of Jared Wheeler Higbee and Blanche A. Son. He had six siblings: Henry E, Valentine Emanuel, Alice M, Helen O, George Clarence, and Florence E. He died at the age of eight months on 08 Oct 1888 in Whitman, Washington.

Orpha Jane Scott was born on 29 Feb 1872 as the first child of Charles Benjamin Scott and Sarah Ann Bonnett. She died on 08 Dec 1888 at the age of 16 in Tekoa, Whitman County.

1. Removal of lilac-brush & weeds from perimeter of cemetery.
2. We will be renting a gas power weed whacker mower and continue expanding lilac removal in paths and around grave sites.
3. Clean and reset grave stones with outdoor liquid glue as needed.
Spray areas of lilac & weed removal as needed.
4. Work with and supervise Upper Columbia Academy students on Wed.
5. Make piles of debris to fill in low areas or to burn this winter.
